#### DAILY DROP OFF & PICK UP

AIM KIDZ campers should be dropped off and picked up at the glass doors of the blue trimmed building. Drive between the 2 buildings entering from Daigle Road and exiting onto Airline Hwy. You will need to check your camper in using the Brightwheel app as you drop off your child. You will get car tags with a QR Code on the back to make it easy to use app and check in and out. If you do not want to use app you can always use the kiosk and enter your unique 4 digit code.

\*\*If you have campers in both AIM camp and Kidz camp, please drop off AIM camper first then circle through parking lot by Airline and stop when you get close to the Kidz drive and the door worker will come and get your camper! Please do not leave car to come and bring your child to the building.

When you are coming to pick up your child in the afternoon, please have your car tag hanging from mirror so that we can call your camper and have him/her ready for you. Each person that is on the approved pick up list will have a unique 4 digit code. YOU MUST SET THEM UP IN BRIGHTWHEEL in order for them to get a code and be on your list. They do not have to download the app as use it (although WAY EASIER) if they do not want to but they must know code to use on kiosk.

\*\*If you have campers in both AIM camp and Kidz camp, please pick up AIM camper first then circle through parking lot by Airline and stop when you get close to the Kidz drive and the door worker will bring your camper(s) to the car! Please do not leave car to come and get your child.

AIM Camp and Kidz camp use the same Drive to exit onto Airline in the afternoon. Please be patient if you have to wait in a line.

#### LET'S EAT

AIM KIDZ CAMP will provide morning snack at 9:00, lunch at 11:30 and afternoon snack at 3:00. If a camper arrives early (6:30-8:30am) and needs breakfast, feel free to send it with them. Any outside food sent for early morning breakfast must be in disposable bags or containers. Please do not send outside food as a part of the 3 eating times that AIM provides. If your child has food allergies then please let us know when registering.

#### **DISCIPLINE POLICY:**

While we expect small issues with behavior and address those as they occur, we want to communicate clearly our policy concerning behavior issues that escalate.

#### AiM KiDZ 1 WiLL NOT PERMIT:

- 1. Offensive language or behavior, towards another child or teacher.
- 2. Repeatedly ignoring staff directions or corrections.
- 3. Hitting / Slapping/ grabbing or aggressive behavior with another child or staff member.
- 4. Repeated disrespect for AIM Kidz 1 rules / policies.

Repeated disregard for the rules will result in the following write up process:

#### TIME OUT:

- 1. Time out shall not be used for children age 2.
- 2. A time out shall take place within the sight of staff.
- 3. The length of each time out shall be based on the age of the child and shall not exceed 1 minute per year of age.

#### PARENT CONTACT:

We will contact campers parents via Brightwheel app if we feel that a situation has occurred in which you need to be notified.

If a child's behavior causes danger to another camper or staff member then your child will be asked to leave the program.

#### EACH DAY OF CAMP PROVIDES DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPERS:

Campers are divided into groups based on their age. If campers being in a group with their friends or siblings creates discipline problems, they will be separated. We maintain an average of 12-16 campers per group. This is dictated by the age of the campers in each group.

**FITNESS / GAMES** the campers will be engaging in activities that will help them with overall motor skill development. They will have activities that will teach hand - eye coordination as well as general good old fashion fun game playing! Who doesn't love a game of tag or basketball?

**PLAYGROUND!** Before it gets too hot... the campers will get to go outside and play in the playground on the equipment. They will get free play outside. This is a great time for them to develop social skills and learn how to play with one another without having a teacher guide their interactions.

**COOKING** is a fun and engaging way to teach children. It has been used for years as a development tool for all ages. Our hands on cooking activities will help campers develop pride and confidence in their abilities, with a tasty treat to enjoy as a reward.

AIM KIDZ CAMP does have a dress code. Campers should wear CAMP t-shirts everyday and stretch shorts with NO buttons or zippers please. Shoes for camp are strictly VELCRO tennis shoes. No sandals. EXTRA CLOTHES: VERY IMPORTANT An extra set of clothes NEEDS TO BE KEPT IN <u>SUMMER CAMP BAG</u>. Use a large zip lock bag and send an extra pair of shorts, shirt, underwear and socks. Accidents do happen and we want to be prepared for spills, mud puddles, cooking incidents, potty accidents, etc. Please label any items that your child brings to AIM Kidz!

- AIM Kidz does not give any refunds on registration fees or daily or weekly tuition.

#### Drop off & Pick up

- 1. Drop off is done between the 2 buildings. You drop off at glass doors of blue trim building by the playground.

- 3. You need to be here by 8:30 am each day.
- 4. You need Car Tag EVERY day when you pick up child!
- 5. If you pick up before 4:00 pm please stop at metal doors and ring the bell.
