

AIM Recreational Gymnastics New Policies due to COVID-19 – Fall 2020

1. Please read over all these policies as you will need to sign at registration that you understand and are in agreement. These new policies are being implemented for the safety of your children, our staff, and the entire community. These policies are brought on by guidance from the CDC and local government agencies.
2. These policies are in effect throughout Fall 2020. Policies will only be altered if government regulations/guidance change.
- 3. Cancelled Classes**
 - a. If we have to close the facility due to uncontrollable circumstances, we will do one of the following depending on the number of days that the facility must close.
 - i. If we have to close 1 - 4 weeks we will do Make - up Vouchers. These will be scheduled via your customer portal. We will send out information about this when and if the time comes.
 - ii. If we have to close more than 5 weeks we will stop the remaining drafts for those that have selected the draft option.
 - iii. If you have paid in full we will credit your account for all unused classes. The balance will be able to be used on any of the AIM programs, Gymnastics, Ninja, Parties, Camp, or KNO.
 - b. THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS.
- 4. Lobby Changes and Class Start and Dismissal**
 - a. All doors to AIM will remain locked. This is to limit the number of people in the building at all times.
 - b. All classes will be dismissed 2 minutes before their scheduled end time. Please make sure you are here on time.
 - c. Recreational Gymnastics (R1-4), Tumbling, Flip Flop
 - i. Will enter and exit the facility through the DAIGLE DOUBLE DOORS.
 - ii. Class start: Park in the Daigle lot and wait in your car or outside your vehicle. Please do not congregate together. The coach will walk outside and wave a flag. When you see the coach waving the flag, this is your cue to walk your child to the coach. DO NOT send your child through the lot on their own.
 - iii. Class dismissal: Park in the lot. Get out of your vehicle and wait on the concrete outside the double doors. The coach will dismiss all classes 2 minutes before their end time.
 - iv. When classes are ending and starting at the same time, please patient as we dismiss the previous classes before walking your child to the concrete. WAIT FOR THE COACH TO WAVE THE FLAG.
 - d. Preschool Classes (P1-4)
 - i. Will enter and exit the facility through the front glass doors.
 - ii. One parent is still required to stay and view class from upstairs.
 - iii. Classes will be dismissed 2 minutes before their scheduled end time.
 - iv. When classes are ending and starting at the same time, all children and parents will be dismissed from the lobby BEFORE the next classes will be allowed to enter the lobby.
- 5. VIEWING CLASSES**
 - a. You are still welcome to view your child's class, but now with restrictions.
 - b. You are responsible for your own social distancing while upstairs. Please remain six feet apart as much as possible. We have added additional benches upstairs to help with this.
 - c. PRESCHOOL PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY FOR THE ENTIRETY OF CLASS.
 - d. Please limit your viewing to one parent and NO CHILDREN.
- 6. BATHROOMS**

- a. Please have children potty before leaving home. If we can avoid needing to use the restroom while at class, this will greatly aid in children and parents coming into unnecessary contact with each other.

7. CLEANING

- a. All children and parents entering the facility will be required to use hand sanitizer.
- b. Children will use hand sanitizer when rotating events.
- c. The facility and all equipment and matting has been sanitized with a special spray that continues to disinfect for 90 days. We will continue to disinfect daily before classes and at the end of the night.

8. Health safety precautions

- a. All persons entering the facility will have their temperature checked. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter the facility.
- b. Please understand that gymnastics/tumbling is an active environment where children will be coming into contact with each other.
- c. This sport requires coaches to be in close contact with their students and to be hands-on with spotting. Coaches will only wear masks during a mask mandate.
- d. Water fountains will be closed. Children will be able to use the bottle filler feature on the fountain located in the gym. Please send your children to gym class with a non-spill bottle that is no more than 10 inches tall. Anything more than 10 inches will not fit in the cubbies.**
